

KNOW YOUR SCHEME

BIJU SWASTHYA KALYAN YOJANA

1. What is Biju Swasthya Kalyan Yojana ?

Biju Swasthya Kalyan Yojana is a scheme of the Government of Odisha, which aims to provide universal health coverage, with special emphasis on the health protection of economically vulnerable families. To achieve its objectives, the BSKY has two components:

- A.** Free health services for all (irrespective of income, status or residence) in all State Government health care facilities starting from Sub center level up to District Head Quarter Hospital level.
- B.** Annual Health coverage of Rs.5 lakh per family and Rs 7 lakh for the women members of the family, for over 70 lakh economically vulnerable families in the State.

2. Who is eligible ?

- A.** All families are eligible for free health care services at Government health care Institutions up to District Head Quarter Hospital level.
- B.** For annual health coverage of Rs 5 lakh per annum per family and Rs 7 lakh per annum for women members of the family, all currently enrolled Biju Krushak Kalyan Yojana card holders, Rashtriya Swasthya Bima Yojana card holders and families with annual income below Rs. 50,000/- in rural areas and below Rs. 60,000/- in urban areas are eligible.

3. What are the benefits under Biju Swasthya Kalyan Yojana Scheme ?

- A.** All health services are free of cost, including free drugs, free diagnostics, free dialysis, free Cancer chemotherapy, free OT, free I.C.U, free in-patient admission etc., in all government health institutions up to District Head Quarters Hospital level, for all persons.
- B.** Families having BKKY card, RSBY card and annual income of Rs 50,000/- in rural and Rs. 60,000/- in urban areas can avail cashless treatment at all Government Hospitals and 208 empanelled Private Hospitals.

4. In which hospital will the beneficiaries get free treatment ?

- A.** Under universal health coverage free health care to all in Public Health Care Institutions from Sub-centre to District Head Quarters Hospitals.
- B.** BKKY and RSBY card holders can avail cashless treatment at all public health care facilities and 208 empanelled private health care institutions.

5. Is there any enrolment process ?

There is no enrolment process for time being. All enrolled families covered under BKKY Stream I & II, RSBY and families with annual income below Rs. 50,000/- in rural areas and below Rs. 60,000/- in urban areas are eligible under the scheme.

6. What are the documents required to be produced for getting Rs. 5 lakh health coverage per annum per family and Rs. 7 lakh health coverage per annum for women members of the family ?

For getting Rs. 5 lakh health coverage per annum per family and Rs. 7 lakh health coverage per annum for women members of the family, the existing Biju Krushak Kalyan Yojana (Stream I & II) and Rashtriya Swasthya Bima Yojana cards have to be produced at the empanelled hospital. For low-income families who do not have BKKY or RSBY card, valid income certificate (annual income below Rs. 50,000/- in rural areas and below Rs. 60,000/- in urban areas) or BPL card or AAY card is to be produced at the empanelled hospital, for availing cashless treatment.

7. What is premium of Biju Swasthya Kalyan Yojana ?

Enrolled beneficiary families do not have to pay any premium. Government is paying the full premium on behalf of the beneficiary family.

8. What about treatment of beneficiaries having some diseases before launching of the Scheme ?

Treatment for all pre-existing conditions are covered under the scheme

9. Who is there to facilitate at point of service ?

Swasthya Mitras are deployed at help desk in each empanelled hospital to facilitate the beneficiaries.
