No registration will be allowed in any case after schedule time of registration .Candidates will submit a set of self attested photocopies of all the certificates / testimonials in support of age, qualification and experience, Candidates are also required to submit two recent passport size colour photographs and self photo ID proof (Voter ID card / PAN card / Driving License / Adhar card / Passport) and recent Residential & Caste Certificate issued by the Tahsildar / Sub-Collector etc. (duly attested). No application without a copy of such document shall be entertained /accepted.
